#### 4. 14 Nov. 2019, Activities for Divyang students


On Childrens Day, Red Cross Society organized different sports events in which Divya Jyoti School students and our college students participated.

### 5. 02 Dec. 2019, International Divyang Day


On the Occasion of International Divyang Day, "Divyang Sammam Samaroh" was organized by Red Cross Society for students with disabilities at Ambedkar Hall.
