MINUTES.

A meeting of the IQAC Committee was held on 9.8.2016 in the IQAC room at 3 pm. The minutes of the earlier meeting were read out by the IQAC Coordinator, Smt. S. Pundlik. She gave a review of the various tasks which were in progress for the preparation of the Peer Team Visit. They included:

- Whitewashing of the building, beautifying the main foyer of the building, setting up of a show case to display the various trophies as well as a statue of Goddess Saraswati.
- A flex displaying all the details of the Institution at a glance was

also put up in the main foyer.

- An amount of Rs 25,000 was donated by Shri Parasram Raltri, an alumnus of the college on 30th July, ~~at~~ at the Foundation Day celebrations.
- It was proposed to set up a Digital Display Board as well as prepare name plates for all class rooms and departments with this fund.
- All the teachers donated Rs. 500 each towards the purchase of cement pots for the college.
- All the teachers donated Rs. 1000 each for the Staff Parking in the campus.
- It was decided to celebrate the Birthdays of all the college teachers and staff in the last week of every month.
- The office was also renovated and rearranged and a Bio-metric system was installed in.
- Installation of Wi-fi under the Chips NME-ICT scheme.
- Information regarding Wi-fi facility, timings and zones for the students was also given.
- It was decided to sign MOUs with local schools, colleges,

Public sector undertakings, insurance companies, law college etc., and more than four MoUs have been signed.

- Information about the various government schemes implemented by the college such as Aanganbadi, Gunwala Unnayan Abhiyan, Unnat Bharat Abhiyan, etc., was also given.
- Process of online admissions was also described and it was informed that this college had registered the maximum number of online admissions in the Affiliating University.
- Information was also given about the setting up of a Study Centre in the Dept of Sociology.
- Activities of NSS, NCC, YRC and Sports were highlighted.
- Proposal for autonomous status was sent and it was informed that semester system of examination for the Post graduate classes have begun from the current academic year.
- All the members were requested to log in to the Institutional website.
- Proposal for upgrading and automation of library.

- IQAC has proposed to organize a series of one-day workshops on various topics such as admission procedures, purchase rules, induction for new teachers and new students, RTI, Income Tax, Lok Sewa Guarantee, Spiritual Awareness, Personality Development, Career counselling, Communication Skills etc.
- Details of RUSA and its role in the development of the college and the construction of eight new rooms under its scheme were discussed.
- Upgrading of the girls Common Room with a Sanitary Napkin Vending Machine and Incinerator was also done.
- Publication and distribution of 'Urja', the annual magazine of the college.
- Fencing of the college boundary with barbed wires and tree plantation by PHE under proposal.
- Proposal for separate transformer for the college sent to CSEB and proposal for donation of generator by Hindustan Petroleum.

- On the occasion of Foundation Day the following announcements were made by the Mayor, Smt. Renu Agrawal, for the college: 1) Four Wheeler Parking, 2) Cement benches and 3) Decoration and painting of the front boundary wall.
- Shri Luteshwar Chauhan, Chairman of the Jan Bhagidari Samiti announced the reduction of 100 Rs in the fees for JB from all students on 30th July, This was applauded by the team members.
- The college conducts several exams of VYAPAM and this year a certificate/letter of appreciation was received from VYAPAM for the successful completion of PRE-MEDICAL test on June 15, 2016 as coordinator centre of Korba district.
- The efforts of Dr. Sanjay Yadav in successful completion of online admission procedure for 1st year degree courses was highly appreciated.
- Mr. Pradeep Kshetriyal gave valuable tips and suggestions for making the college a Differently Abled Friendly Institution and conducting activities to highlight them at institutional and district level.

- Focus on bringing these special students into the mainstream and giving them proper exposure and motivation.
- An MOU with Divya Tyoti Special School for providing help for blind students. Work on 'Talking Book' for the blind students is already in progress by the Smt. S. Pundlik.
- Suggestion for creation of E-library with audios for the college students. Was given by Mr. Khetrapal.
- Dr. R. K. Saxena suggested the starting of an awareness programme regarding edu facilities for the prisoners of the Central Jail but the general outcome was not very positive towards this proposal.
- Dr. H. P. Khairwar gave useful information regarding provision of computer literacy through Bilaspur University for the college staff.
- It was suggested that all the teachers may record few lectures and upload it in the library and later on the college website.

- Dr. H. P. Khairwar stressed on the need to work on the weak points and highlight the strengths.
- Dr. S. K. Goblil suggested the need to focus on the academic side and focus on practical methods of teaching (eg:- conducting mock parliament sessions for Political Science dept.)
